Ultimate Image Salon & Spa helps cancer survivors look good and feel better. Women undergoing cancer treatment have many things on their minds. The last thing they are probably concerned about is what type of wig to wear or what type of makeup to use. That is where Joanne Rosini and Angela Lewis volunteer for The American Cancer Society's Look Good, Feel Better Program.

Women attending the sessions learn about scarves, hair and skin care options. Patients in various stages of treatment receive make-over tips and personal attention from Angela and Joanne. They also use and take home complimentary cosmetic kits in their appropriate skin tones (light, medium, dark, extra dark) with helpful instruction booklets.

Joanne and Angela are particularly skilled in wig styling and they often care for many guests in the salon who are undergoing cancer treatments. They educate women on wigs and the programs available to them through the American Cancer society.

The Look Good, Feel Better Program hosts local sessions at Montgomery Hospital every other month. The first half of the program educates women on wig construction, quality, and fiber to make sure individuals chose the wig best suited for their needs. The second half of the program focuses on cosmetics and skin care, and educates women on how to apply and use makeup.

Its a friendly atmosphere and they get to meet people going through the same things they are.
